In celebration of our 5th-anniversary conference, which emphasizes intercultural dialogue, we are excited to feature workshops on Japanese culture. Additionally, the event will include the online premiere of a haiku poetry collection in Polish, German, and English.

Due to the international, bilingual nature of the conference, there will be a possibility to give **15-minute** presentations in **English** and **German**.

After the Conference, we plan to publish the fourth edition of the peer-reviewed collective monograph *New Vistas in Language Studies. Young Scholars' Perspectives* in an online format, which will be published by the University of Rzeszow Publishing House (which for Polish participants means a scored publication). The condition for publication is that the authors of the papers receive positive reviews and follow the editorial guidelines, which will be provided to all Participants by e-mail in a later date.
